



## Water Care Guidelines Traditional Water Care Products

We hope you enjoy your hot tub! These easy to follow instructions will keep you and your spa happy and healthy.

### For Startup

Refer to your spa owner's manual for the gallons of your hot tub. Add the following amounts of each water care product from the table below. Water care products should be added to the filter bay, and your jets should be run for at least twenty minutes.

Gallon Capacity	SeaKlear Calcium Increaser	SeaKlear Alkalinity Up	SeaKlear Sanitizing Granules
130-275	8 oz	1½ scoops	¼ scoop
276-420	10 oz	2½ scoops	¼ scoop
421-500	16 oz	4 scoops	¼ scoop

**Note**—For dry measurements, our plastic scoop is equal to 2 ounces. Liquid products have ounce measurements on the side of the bottle.

**After each use**—Add ¼ scoop of SeaKlear Sanitizing Granules and run the Clean Cycle, or run your jets for 10-15 minutes.

**Every week**—Test your alkalinity and pH levels and adjust as needed. Add 1 SilkBalance Shock Gem\* and run the Clean Cycle, or run your jets for 10-15 minutes. NOTE—If you have two jet pumps, please run both jet pumps during this cycle, not just the pump activated by the Clean Cycle. Turn all diverter valves to each position while running your jet pumps, to ensure circulation through all plumbing.

\*If Shock Gems are not available, you can instead add ½ scoop SeaKlear Balanced Spa Shock.

### Hardness

Calcium hardness is only added at startup, according to the startup chart. You will not deal with hardness again until you drain and refill your spa.

### To Test Alkalinity & pH

1. Dip the test strip in the water and swish—leave strip in the water for at least five seconds.
2. Lightly shake to remove excess water—wait 15 seconds before comparing to the color chart on the side of the test strip bottle. NOTE—you will only get a good reading if compared within 30 seconds.
3. **For low alkalinity**—Follow the directions on the label of the SeaKlear Alkalinity Up to determine the proper amount to add. Alkalinity *cannot* be lowered. If too high, drain the spa and start over with fresh water.
4. **For low pH**—Add 1 ounce per 100 gallons of SeaKlear pH Increaser. **For high pH**—Add 1 ounce per 100 gallons of SeaKlear pH Reducer. If you do adjust your pH, *wait until the next day to repeat testing*

**Every month**— Clean your filters with SeaKlear Filter Cleaner. Rinse thoroughly before placing back in your hot tub.

**Every four months**—Drain and refill your hot tub with new water. Clean & condition your cover with 303 Protectant.

**Every year**—If applicable, clean your ozone system, according to the instructions in your hot tub owner's manual. If you need additional assistance, please contact our Service Center. NOTE—It is recommended that you also periodically use Clean Start to clean your plumbing before adding new water
